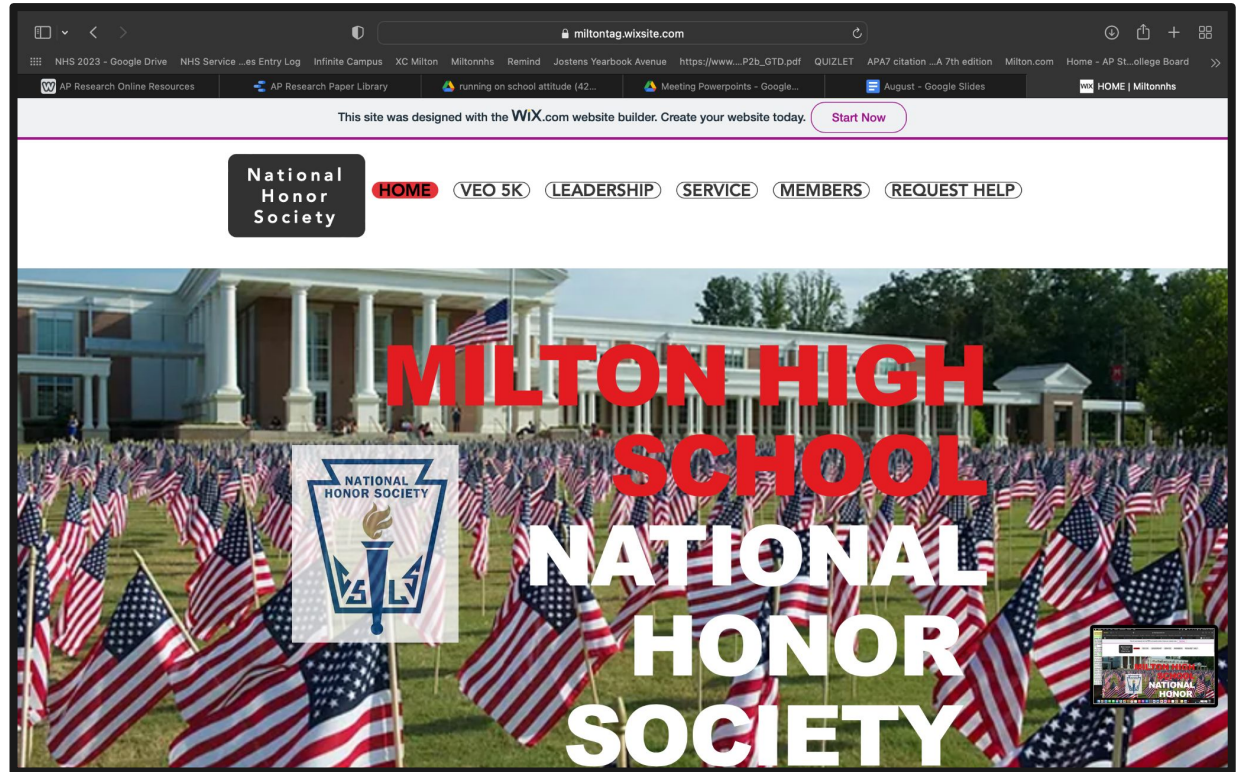
NHS STANDARDS

- **Character** is the **personal commitment** to ethical and compassionate decision making that affects oneself and others.

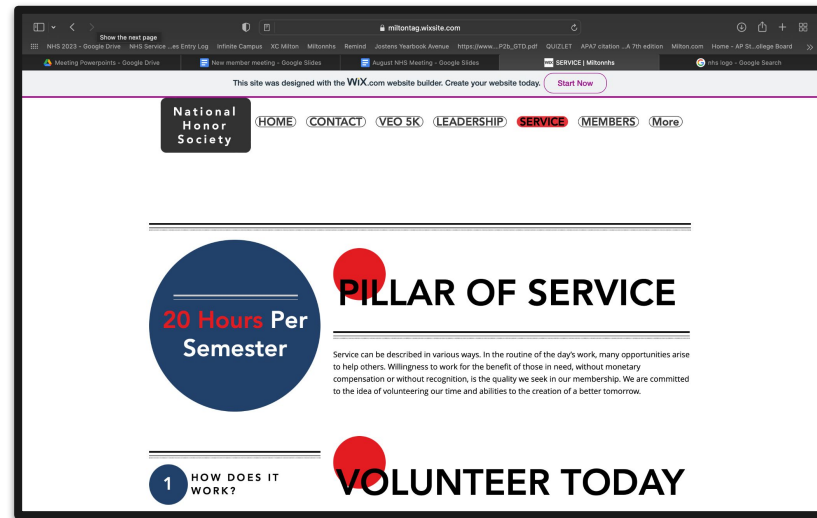

IMPORTANT POLICIES

- If you miss an event/drop out less than 48 hours in advance and do not find a replacement, you will be required to get two additional hours and a second offense results in six additional hours

 - Not showing up or canceling last minute will result in extra hours being required!!

- Edit the opportunity in the Activities log if rejected





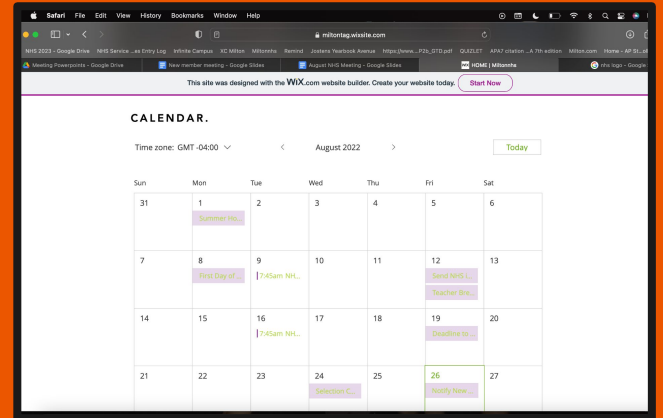
Important Policies

If you do not remain in good standing with NHS, you will be put on probation. On probation, you must get all your missing hours from last semester, along with 5 ADDITIONAL service hours, on top of the 20 hours required per semester.

If you miss an event/drop out less than 48 hours in advance, you must find a replacement, and if not, you must get 2 additional hours (This means 22 required hours). If it happens a second time, you must get 6 additional hours (26 required hours). This will be closely monitored!!

Monthly Meetings

- Attend General meetings every month on Teams
- Meeting Attendance will be taken
- If you miss one you have a **warning**
- If you miss two you will be considered for **probation** (1 extra hour for every meeting missed)

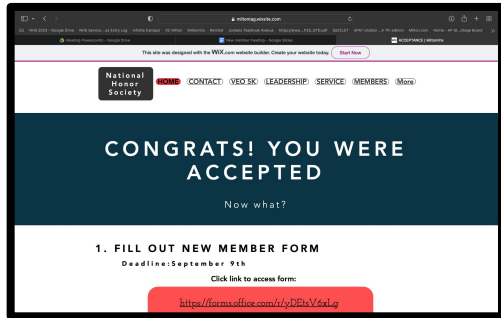

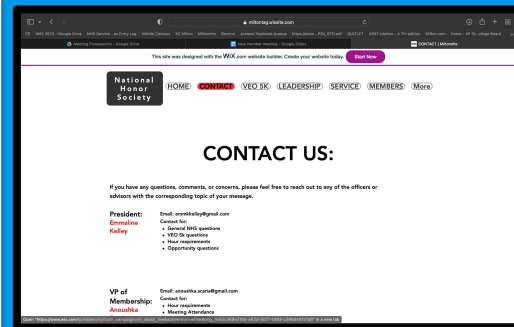
